What: Campout (2 nights - Friday and Saturday night, depart Sunday)
Where: Percy Quin State Park, Mississippi
When: Fri-Sat-Sun Oct 10, 11, 12 2008
Why: To learn scouting values of character, spiritual growth, citizenship, sportsmanship, fitness, family, respect, achievement, service, fun and adventure!

DETAILS:

- St Angela school-wide early dismissal Friday Oct 10 at 11:30
- This early dismissal allows us the opportunity to leave in the early afternoon on Friday
- Families travel on your own and depart when you can in private vehicles Friday Oct 10 around 1:00 PM if possible so that we can get to Percy Quinn early, tents pitched in the daytime, etc.
- If parents cannot get out of work early, please come when you can
- When you arrive, check in at the Percy Quin gate (Ranger Station) and you will be provided instructions to the tent campsite (Percy Quinn won't pinpoint our exact campsite until our arrival. The scout area is all the way in the back of Percy Quinn, past the lake and past the dam.
- Don't pay at the gate – we will pay for the whole pack as a group.
- Directions to Percy Quinn are easy - about 101 miles – take I-10 West to Laplace; take I-55 North toward Hammond; shortly after entering Mississippi, take MS-48 (EXIT 10) toward Magnolia; turn left on MS-48 West; follow signs to Percy Quinn; tell the ranger at the gate you are with St. Angela's Cub Scout Pack 30/Girl Scout Troop 671 and he/she will direct you to the campsite.
- We'll depart Percy Quinn about 10:30 AM Sunday Oct 12, 2008. We plan to have a brief outdoor religious prayer service Sunday morning at 9:00 AM.
- Sleeping arrangements: families sleep as a unit in their own tent.
- Indoor restroom with toilet & sink walking distance to campsite
- Available activities include nature walks (opportunity to earn badges, pins and Leave No Trace award), nightly campfire, hiking, fishing, and biking (bring your own bikes & fishing gear). Each Den will sponsor a specific Den Activity. About 10 miles away in McComb, there is a "restored" steam engine, freight cars and a depot. On Sat night: Halloween TENT-O-TREATING! Bring your costume for some nighttime tent-to-tent trick or treating. Parents, please bring a bag of treats to pass out from your tent and decorate your car or tent site to get into the "spirit"!

Tent, Tarp (for under tent), Broom/dustpan for tent, Hammer (for tent stakes)
Knife (for adults only) - (optional)
First Aid kit
Canteen, hat, sunglasses, bug spray, sunscreen, raingear, poncho, whistle
Sleep clothes or pajamas
Extra clothes, shorts, shirt, sweatpants, sweatshirt, socks, shoes (in case of
rain or adventures in the mud)
Underwear, handkerchiefs
Toiletries, toothbrush, toothpaste, toilet paper, shampoo, soap, comb, brush
Towel
Trash Bags, Shovel - (optional)
Walkie-talkies, batteries - (optional)
Camera. Batteries, film - (optional)
beach shoes, sandals or flip-flops, swim suit - (optional – seasonal)
duffle bag, backpack or small suitcase (to carry your gear)

Don't bring:

Gameboys, PSPs, radios, Nintendos, etc. Adults – please don't bring alcohol
